Our school uniform is important to us. It is one way in which we identify ourselves as a school family and it promotes a strong, cohesive school identity which supports high standards and expectations in all areas of school life. It promotes harmony between different groups represented in the school and it enhances security.

At SS. Peter & Paul Catholic Primary School we believe that a school uniform is important, because it:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- is practical and smart
- identifies the children with the school
- is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be)
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents
- is designed with health and safety in mind.

Our colours are navy, grey and white and the uniform is as follows, and is compulsory.

Nursery

- PE bag with logo containing spare clothes in case of accident.
- Navy blue sweatshirt with the school logo
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue shorts may be worn in the summer
- PE t - shirt with school logo (blue)
- Girls may wear white or navy socks
- Boys may wear navy or grey socks.
- Children must wear a navy coat; the school coat with logo is available.
- Hair accessories must be navy.
- Black shoes – Velcro, no lace ups

Reception

- PE bag with logo containing spare clothes in case of accident
- Plain navy skirt for girls and grey trousers for boys.
- All children must wear a white shirt and the school tie.
- The school jumper/ cardigan with the school logo on must be worn.
- Light blue gingham dresses may be worn in the summer term. Please ensure they are light blue and checked, not striped.
- Girls may wear white or navy socks, or navy tights
- Boys may wear navy or grey socks.
- Black school shoes- Velcro, no lace ups.
- Children must wear a navy coat; the school coat with logo is available.
- Hair accessories must be navy.

Key Stage 1 and 2

Boys

- Grey trousers for boys.
- Grey shorts with side pockets may be worn in the summer
- Long sleeved white shirt and the school tie.
- Short sleeved white shirt and school tie may be worn in the summer
- The school jumper/ cardigan with the school logo on must be worn
- Boys may wear navy or grey socks
- Black school shoes
- Must wear a navy coat; the school coat with logo is available

Girls

- Plain navy skirt for girls
- Long sleeved white shirt and the school tie.
- Short sleeves white shirt and school tie may be worn in the Summer
- Light blue gingham dresses may be worn in the summer term. Please ensure they are light blue and checked, not striped.
- The school jumper/ cardigan with the school logo on must be worn
- Black school shoes
- Girls may wear white or navy socks, or navy tights
- Must wear a navy coat; the school coat with logo is available
- Hair accessories must be navy.

PE

Reception/ Key stage 1

- School PE T-shirt with school logo (blue)
- Navy shorts/ navy tracksuit bottoms for winter
- Plimsolls
- PE bag with school logo

Key stage 2

- School PE T-shirt with school logo (blue)
- Navy shorts/ navy tracksuit bottoms for winter
- A pair of trainers
- PE bag with school logo

Compulsory school rucksack with school logo

There are two sizes available; one for EYFS/Infants and a bigger size for juniors

Optional items

- School cap with school logo (Summer term)
- School coat with logo/ reversible fleece

Jewellery

- On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. **No earrings, necklaces or bracelets.**
- Wrist watches are allowed

Hairstyles

- Long hair should be tied up for Health and Safety reasons.
- Fashions evolve over time and we remain aware of changes in trends, but no extreme hair - cuts or style or extremes of fashion are acceptable - “artwork” on the scalp and shave-patterned are regarded as a fashion extreme.

Footwear

We require all children to wear black shoes, plain black, with no hidden toys, coloured tabs or illuminations.

We ask all SS. Peter & Paul parents to support the school uniform policy.

We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child’s name.
