Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another very successful week at school with Pod 1 returning. Please ensure that you bring your child to school on time. We have had some instances of lateness and it makes it very difficult for us to ensure temperatures are taken and that the pods remain separate.

If you wish for your child to return to school, you must inform us through parentsupport. We then have to plan what group best meets the needs of your child. If you are a Key Worker or your child is considered vulnerable, they will be included in a group of mixed ages from Nursery to Year 6. As the groups are already established and have been together since April, we cannot move them or group them by age. Please remember, these children will not be being taught. This is primarily childcare. It is most likely that they will not have their class teacher. Some groups will have TA.

As the weather is very hot, please remember to send in a large bottle of water (enough for the school day), a sun hat and sun cream for your child. We are not permitted to use fans at the moment as they can increase the chance of the virus being spread if someone has it. We are doing our best by keeping all windows and doors open.

Many families came to collect the books that we have purchased. If you have not, please contact the school office to arrange an appropriate time.

Next week, 29<sup>th</sup> June is the feast of St Peter and St Paul. Please take a moment in your own homes to celebrate our namesake, as we will do in school.
