Dear Parents and Carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming those invited children back into school on Monday. The staff have worked very hard and have now finalised all preparations ahead of welcoming back Year 6, 1, Reception and Nursery. All PPE and required equipment has arrived which means we are able to proceed with our plan that the school governors approved.

We have contacted all families who indicated that they wish to return. Parents need to ensure they check the date and time on their letter. If your child is brought to school for the incorrect week, we will have to turn them away. We do not wish to cause unnecessary upset, but the child to staff ratio has been planned very carefully and additional children cannot be added into groups at the last minute.

If your child requires medication, please send it in with your child in a sealed ziplock bag and give to me.

It is very important for parents/carers to observe the two metre distance from the classrooms especially in EYFS. We ask all parents to wait until your child's temperature is taken.
