### **Return to School**

Children return to school on **Thursday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September** for our next academic year. We will have a soft start when we return to school, with children from Nursery to Year 6 being able to arrive from 8:30-8:45am. School will officially begin at 8:45am for Nursery to Year 6. School will end at 3:00pm for all children in Reception to Year 6 and Nursery will finish at 2.45pm.

Children who arrive at school after 8.45am will be marked late in the register.

Reception and Nursery children can be brought to the door of the classroom by parents/ carers.

Year 3-6 will enter by the Junior gate and walk to their classrooms where their teacher will be waiting for them.

Year 1 and Year 2 will enter between 8:30am and 8:45am from the junior gate and be dismissed from the EYFS gate at 3:00pm.

We will continue the protocol of having parents and carers waiting outside the school building at collection time from Year 1 to Year 6.
